Participants face unique challenges developing solutions for real-world scenarios ensuring they showcase technical skills while navigating practical constraints and industry standards, making it stand out from traditional hackathons.



HOW TO REGISTER?



- Visit the PearlHack official website <https://pearlhack.lk/> and choose the competition you wish to participate in (**Ideathon** or **Designathon**).
- Go to the 'Register' section and fill out the registration form with the required details.
- Provide your team information, including the **team name**, **university**, and **team leader's details**.
- Enter contact details for the team leader and all team members.
- Submit the registration form before the deadline.
- Keep track of important dates mentioned on the website.
- Registration **opens on Nov 29th**, and all participants must register as part of a team



RULES AND REGULATIONS



- Female undergraduates of any University or Higher Educational Institute are eligible to participate in this competition.
- A team must consist of a minimum of 3 members and a maximum of 4 members. Participants in a team should represent the same University or the Higher Educational Institute.
- A team can only participate in one category (Either Ideathon or Designathon).
- The judges' decision will be the final decision.

GUIDELINES FOR THE DESIGNATHON



- Submissions must be the original work of the participant/team.
- Plagiarism or use of uncredited third party materials will result in disqualification.
- Submissions for each stage must be made before the specified deadlines.
- All participants will receive a predefined scenario at the start of the competition.
- Designs and solutions must align with the given scenario.
- The use of AR/VR should enhance the user experience and be relevant to the given scenario.

GUIDELINES FOR THE IDEATHON



- Submissions must be original and developed by the participant/team.
- Use of uncredited third party content or plagiarism will result in disqualification.
- Each round has specific deadlines.
- Late submissions will not be considered.
- The competition will provide a limited scope to ensure a focused and feasible challenge.
- Solutions must align with the given scope and demonstrate the use of AI-based technologies.
